

SSSR2021: Virtual Conference 13 – 16 July 2021: Programme Information

Context

- All **oral presentations** and **posters** will be pre-recorded and uploaded in advance of the conference.
- The sessions in the programme are for the **live scheduled Q&As** for each symposium and each session of individual spoken papers (grouped in themes of 4-6 papers).
- Posters will not have a live Q&A slot: they will be pre-recorded, blocked into themes in the schedule, and each poster will have a chat interface. The content throughout the meeting and beyond. They do not feature in this draft programme.
- The conference timing is British Summer Time (BST).
- The schedule for the live content takes into account multiple time zones, but there are constraints, particularly for symposia that include presenters from around the globe.
- We have scheduled on the basis of presenters stated preferred time slot and/or the time zone for the institutional affiliation.
- All presentations will have an asynchronous 'chat' function.
- The content can be viewed on demand before, during, and after the conference: from 12 July 2021 for 60 days.
